Troubleshooting Readiness Display		
CHARGE-PAK™ charger and electrode pads need to be replaced OR CHARGE-PAK charger is not installed.	Use AED if needed.	
Service needed.	Attempt to use AED in an emergency. If AED is inoperable, retrieve another AED if possible and continue CPR until EMS arrives.	
Internal battery not fully charged.	Verify CHARGE-PAK charger is installed. If CHARGE-PAK charger installed use unit if needed.
